Truck Stand-by	A surcharge per truck applies where an out of hours pour is delayed or cancelled hours deliveries.	\$100.00 per truck per 30 minutes (or part thereof)
Waiting Time	Applies after trucks held onsite for longer than 30 minutes.	\$2.50/minute after the first 30 minutes \$5.00 minute after the first 30 minutes when outside normal working hours

Extra Distance Charge	A distance surcharge applies to leads greater than 20km from the nearest plant.	\$2.50/km/m ³

Environmental Disposal Fee	Applies to any unused concrete returned from the site. On all occasions, customers will be given the choice of taking the excess concrete on their site or have it returned to Aurora at the following costs.
